The Criminal Justice Act 2003 (CJA) made fundamental changes to the admissibility of evidence relating to the defendant ' s character and that of victims or witnesses. Section 103 provides for the admissibility of previous convictions in support of the propensity to commit like offences and/or to be untruthful.
